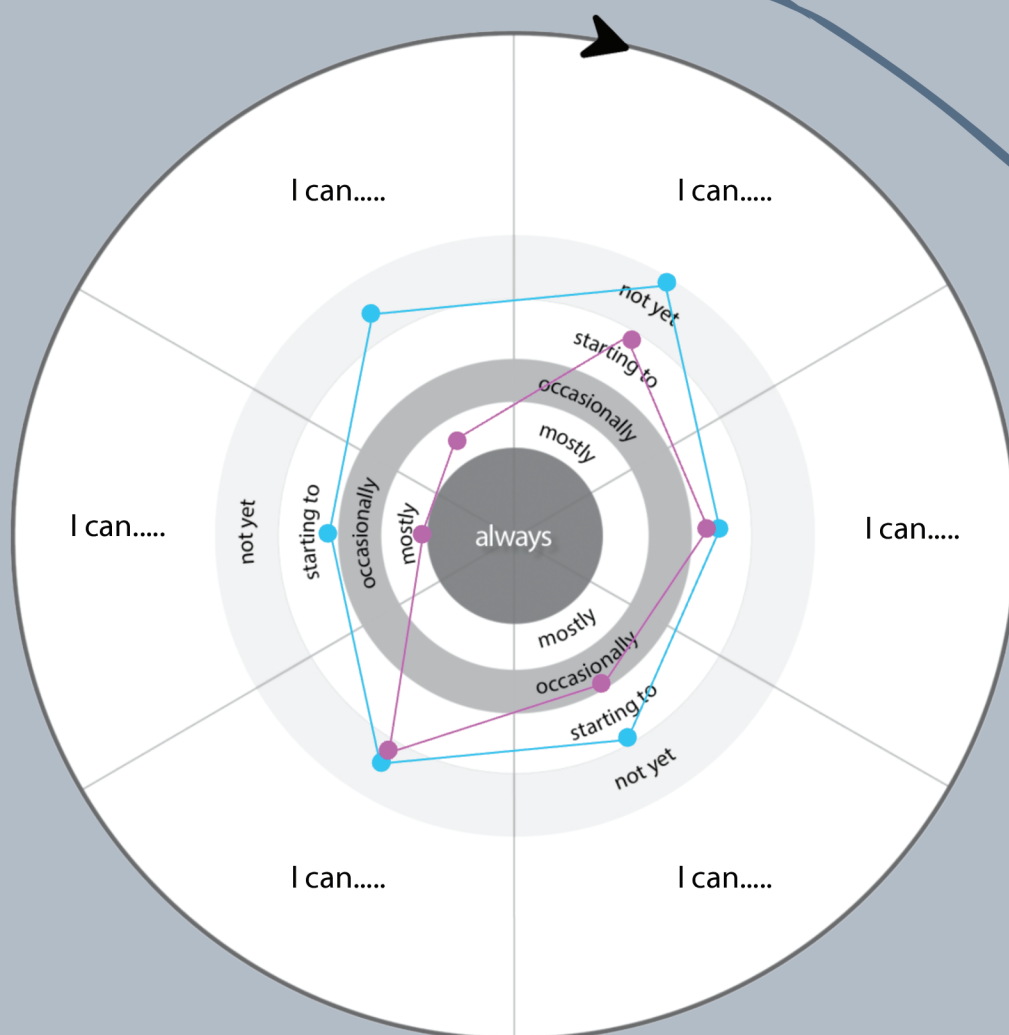
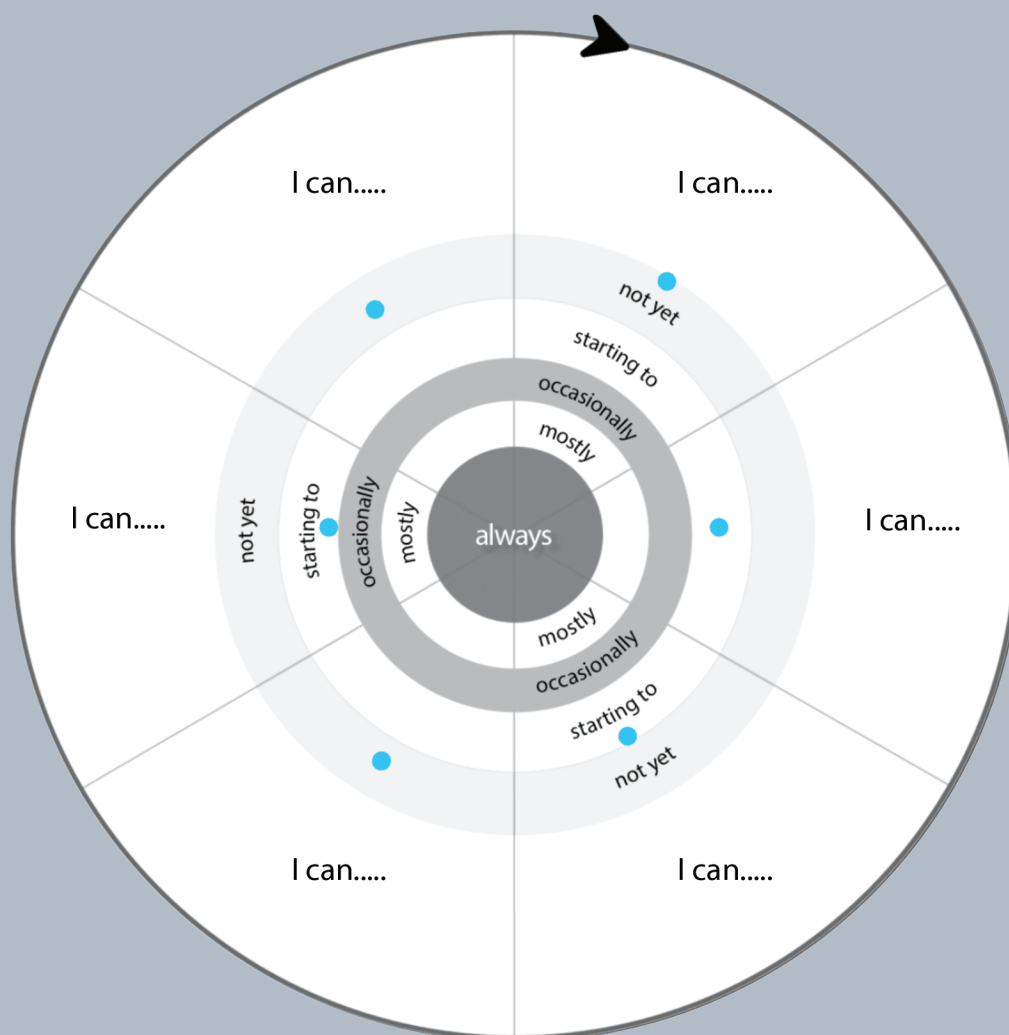
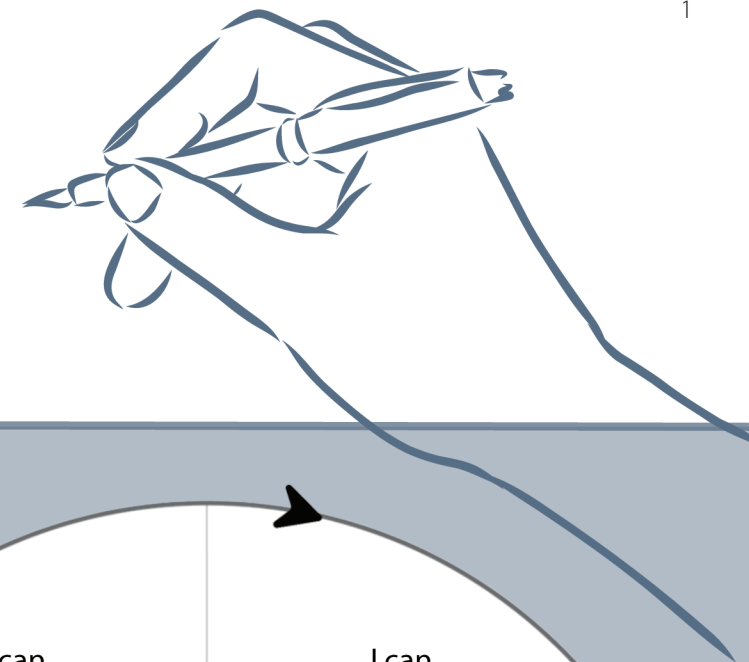
- This tool is for Indigenous language learners to understand and track learning progress
